**\*The Humber Bridge**, "A Grade 1 listed iconic structure linking Lincolnshire and Yorkshire on the A15. The 1.4-mile long bridge was opened in 1981 to create a new, faster route between the two banks of the Humber. It remains the longest single-span suspension bridge in the world to cycle or walk across".

Our journey will start at 10am from [Birchgrove Garden Centre](#), Pinchbeck – PE11 3XY (Breakfast and refreshments available).



If you thought Lincolnshire was flat then our suggested route up through the Lincolnshire Wolds will surely change that opinion.



We will take a lunch break at [Caistor Lakes](#) (see menu) before continuing to our finish at the [Water's Edge Visitor Centre](#), in the shadow of the bridge (refreshments available)
