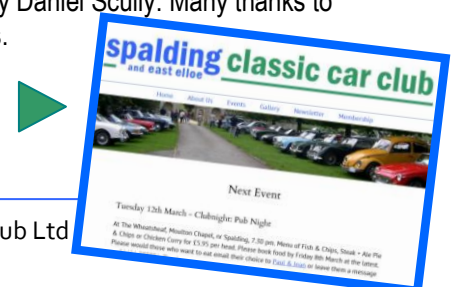
Steve & Liz would also like some classics to put on the stand, so why not ask members of your team to bring their classics along too to go on the stand while you are taking part?

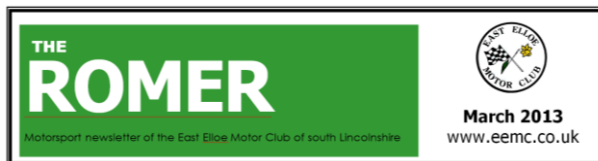
### CHARITY QUEST IN MEMORY OF TIM
