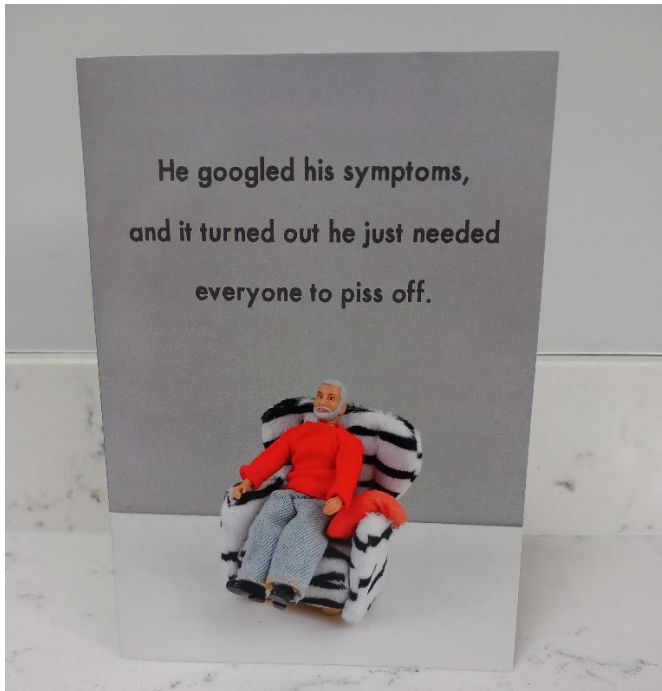
...and the other image shows the pit board from his racing days in the 80s and 90s – weirdly quite fitting now. They say if you keep things long enough they might come in handy!
