He was also a pilot for the Spalding Water Taxi until a few years ago.

Phil was a former Navy man and practised as a dentist in Pinchbeck for many years. He enjoyed regaling tales of his times serving abroad from many years ago, usually with a motoring or nautical theme.

Phil & Sally have always tried to regularly attend clubnights and events despite his advancing years, the last eight or so in his nineties. He was a great supporter of our Club stand at various shows over the years frequently coming along with his car loaded



with a couple of deck chairs which were his only surviving items from another muchloved mode of transport, his sailing boat, Triton.

That was with the original engine but in 2018 the rear core plug failed, so the engine had to be removed as it was smoking badly.

The engine was rebuilt by a specialist in 2019 as the white metaling of the big ends needed an expert to deal with it.





The rebuilt engine is now run in nicely having covered just 600 miles (my wife's illness has prevented me from doing any shows since 2020).

The car also had a new set of tyres and a new dynamo fitted just after the engine was put back in again.
